

Trenton Light & Water Dept.
Utility Board Minutes
October 27, 2025, 8:30AM

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tony Burriss. Others present were Cece Jones, Kim Holt, Rickey Graves, Billie Wade, Peyton Harper, Joe Wamble, Richy Turner, Stacy Rice, Josh Lawler and Bridgette Hill.

The minutes of September 22, 2025, regular meeting was approved unanimously following motion by CeCe Jones, second by Kim Holt.

FY26TD Revenue Summary, Financials and payment totals for 09/22/2025 – 10/26/25 were distributed and reviewed. Motion by Billie Wade and second by Rickey Graves to approve the financial report passed unanimously.

Safety Report: Both the Electric Department and Water/Sewer Department had a safety meeting this month. There were no safety issues. The safety report was approved unanimously following motion by CeCe Jones and second by Kim Holt.

Under Old Business. Sewer Rates will increase 10% effective November 1, 2025. Motion by Peyton Harper and second by CeCe Jones to approve the effective date passed unanimously.

Under New Business. Wamble discussed the concern from citizens about paying sewer charges for septic tanks that TLW installed. A motion was made by Peyton Harper to table the topic.


Under Other Business Wamble stated that the solar farm went online on October 22, 2025, generating electricity for our system. Wamble gave an update that some customers have been connected to Gibson Connect. Wamble also informed the board that our Fruitland Substation needed the current 25-year-old batteries replaced.

Joe Wamble informed the board that the excess capacity charge to Gibson Electric for our Fruitland Substation needed to be increased effective January 1, 2026. Motion by Kim Holt and second by Peyton Harper to approve the increase passed unanimously.

The regular November 2025 Utility Board meeting will be held on Monday, October 24, 2025, at 109 W Armory St at 8:30AM.

With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 9:41AM.
