

Trenton Light & Water Dept.
Utility Board Minutes
June 22, 2026 8:30AM

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tony Burriss. Others present were Cece Jones, Rickey Graves, Billie Wade, Peyton Harper, Joe Wamble, Richy Turner and Bridgette Hill. Visitors were Dr. Jeff Murriel.

The minutes of the May 18, 2026, regular meeting was approved unanimously following motion by Rickey Graves, second by Billie Wade.

FY26TD Revenue Summary and payment totals for 05/18/26-06/21/26 were distributed and reviewed. Motion by CeCe Jones and second by Peyton Harper to approve the financial report passed unanimously.

Safety Report: The Water/Sewer Department had a safety meeting this month. The Electric will be held later this month. There were no safety issues. The safety report was approved unanimously following motion by Billie Wade and second by Rickey Graves.

Under Old Business – Joe Wamble discussed the implementation of sewer billing for city residents who receive their water service through the county water system. Under the proposed policy, affected residents will be required to provide documentation of their water usage for the previous 12 months. This usage information will be used to calculate and bill sewer charges based on the City's established sewer rates. To ensure accurate billing, customers receiving county water service will be required to submit updated 12-month water usage records on an annual basis. If the customer does not provide the usage it will remain at the established flat sewer rate. If the customer does not provide this annually, it will revert back to the established flat sewer rate. Letters will be mailed to the affected customers to giving them the opportunity to submit this information. The proposed policy was approved unanimously following motion by Peyton Harper and seconded by CeCe Jones to take effect October 1, 2026.

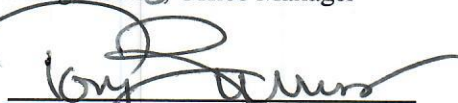
Under New Business – Mr. Wamble discussed the issue at City Limits Bar & Grill dumping raw sewage into the Forked Deer River. Mr. Harrison (City Limits Bar & Grill owner) contacted Mr. Wamble about tapping into the City's Sewer System. Mr. Wamble presented to the board to be responsible for 420' of the new sewer line costing \$9,240.00 with City Limits Bar & Grill paying a flat rate of \$150.00/month as a sewer charge. Motion was made by Rickey Graves and seconded by CeCe Jones to approve the proposal made by Mr. Wamble and add that a lien would be attached to the property to recover the money spent by TLW and passed unanimously.

The regular July 2026 Utility Board meeting will be held on Monday, July 27, 2026, at 109 W Armory Street at 8:30AM.

With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 9:50AM.
